



Initial Consultation Report

The purpose of this report is to summarize the data and goals for your project. Please review the information in this report carefully and report if any additional information is known at project start or if any of the information should be changed or corrected.

Summary of Research Recommendations:

Client has a desire to continue researching the identity of Francesco Antonio Petrucci as well as the identities of any siblings of his who migrated to the U.S. to search for an American document that reports a place of origin for the Petrucci family. On Ancestry member account the names of seven people were reported as being possible siblings to Francesco Petrucci, but it was noted that all were born significantly earlier than Francesco Petrucci. All of the siblings on the Ancestry member account were described as being born from 1848 to 1861 and Francesco A. Petrucci was born much later in 1892. As discussed in previous reports it seems likely that the identities of the proposed siblings to Francesco Petrucci may be inaccurate.

Goals of this survey will be to establish and prove the identities of siblings to our subject that migrated to the U.S. It is important to note a copy of an original death record was previously discovered for our subject Francesco A. Petrucci that reported the names of his parents were Antonio Petrucci and Marianne Spardella.

Genealogist recommends applying up to two hours of research time completing a digital collections survey on the identity of Francesco Antonio Petrucci and the identities of his siblings who shared the same set of parents known as Antonio Petrucci and Marianne Spardella. After the identities of his siblings have been verified and proven from U.S. records genealogist will search to find documentation that reports their specific place of Italian origin.

Digital Collections Survey is a term we use to describe a research survey that exhausts all available collections of documents that are published online including but not limited to Ancestry.com and other premium information service databases. Copies of original documentation may include census, vital, military, probate, land and church records; secondary documentation may include copies of record transcriptions, record index entries and published genealogies.
