



Research Results Report Tara A. Fantauzzi, Professional Genealogist

Summary of Research Results:

One hour and thirty minutes of research time was applied completing a digital collections survey to learn more about the identity of Francesco Antonio Petrucci and the identities of his siblings who shared the same set of parents known as Antonio Petrucci and Marianne Spardella. Genealogist began by searching to verify and prove the identities of siblings from US records with a goal to find documentation that reports their specific place of Italian origin.

- A. Genealogist applied thirty minutes completing searches to find primary sources for siblings to Francesantonio Petrucci who migrated to the U.S. by looking for records that list the identities of a common set of parents, specifically Antonio Petrucci and Marianne Spardella.
- B. Genealogist applied fifteen minutes completing searches on the identity of Gerardo Cartone[Cardone] who was the cousin Francesco Ant. Petrucci and planned to join in U.S. as listed on his ship passenger list.
- C. Genealogist applied thirty minutes completing searches to learn more about places of origin shared by those of the surname Petrucci that settled in or nearby the Rhode Island.
- D. Genealogist applied fifteen minutes completing searches of City Directories for records that list Antonio Petrucci to check if he was linked to Sant'Angelo d'Alife. Genealogist also checked birth index from 1892 in Sant'Angelo d'Alife for birth index entry for our subject, but no match found.

The research survey yielded no positive results. Genealogist was unable to find any primary or secondary records to link the identity of Francesco Antonio Petrucci to the identities of any siblings who shared the same set of parents Antonio Petrucci and Marianne Spardella. Genealogist searched variations of those given names to widen the scope, and after numerous searches no positive findings were found. Genealogist noted throughout the survey that the place San Giovanni Incarico was the most common place of origin for individuals of the surname Petrucci that settled in Rhode Island.



Summary of Research Recommendations:

It seems highly likely our subject Francescantonio Petrucci was born in San Giovanni Incarico, but that conflicts with the fact that a previous request came back negative from that place after searches were completed to find it there. Although not common it may be possible his birth record was overlooked possibly because the identities of his parents were previously misreported.

Genealogist recommends applying up to thirty minutes of correspondence time submitting a request to Italian genealogist Paolo Campagna to submit requests to the municipality of San Giovanni Incarico as well as the Frosinone State Archives to search for a copy of an original birth record for Francesantonio Petrucci, son of Antonio Petrucci and Marianne Spardella. Typically the search fees to Paolo Campagna are about 150 Euro.

Correspondence Time is a term we use to describe research tasks that involve direct contacts with government agencies, historical societies, or other entities to submit requests for documents; often including the completion of formal request forms, emails, or mail correspondence.
