### Summary of Research Results:

Thirty minutes hours of research time was applied completing an on-site digital collections survey of original Italian civil birth, marriage and death records from the City of Torino, Torino, Piemonte, Italy to learn more about the identity of Maddalena Antonia Comorio and her direct ancestors beginning with the identities of her parents Gioachino Giacinto Comorio and Chiara Stapinato.

The research survey yielded three positive results; specifically, a combination of Italian civil birth and marriage records as well as birth index entries related to the identity of Maddalena Antonia Comorio and her parents Gioachino Giacinto Comorio and Chiara Stapinato.

### COMORIO - 1895 Italian Civil Marriage Record for Gioachino Giacinto Comorio & Chiara Stapinato

#### MARRIAGE ACT

##### Number 904, Comorio Giacinto & Stapinato Chiara

In the year 1895, on 28th of November, at 9:25 A.M. at the Municipal Hall of Torino, open to the public before me Cavaliere Carlo B... Consigliere by an act on the 8th of last July and civil registration officer officially appeared personally:

1. **Comorio Giachino Giacinto**, delicatessen owner, born in Pino Torinese on the 5th of March 1870 resident of Moncalieri never previously married, son of the deceased **Giuseppe and Quarà Antonia**,
2. **Stapinato Chiara**, born in Carignano on the 21st of February 1875 resident of Torino, never previously married, daughter of the living Agostino and Mesinardi[?] Maddalena residents of Carignano who made a request of me to unite them in marriage; for this purpose they presented to me the document described below; and from the examination of it including those already produced for the marriage banns, all of which were approved by me and put in the volume of supplemental documents to this register, resulting in nothing to hinder the celebration of their marriage. I read to the bride and groom articles 130, 131, 132 from the Civil Code, and therefore I asked of the groom if he intended to take as a wife the present **Stapinato Chiara** and to her if she intended to take as a husband the present **Comorio Giacinto**; and each of them having answered in the affirmative with the full intelligence of the undersigned witnesses, I pronounced in the name of the law that the same were united in marriage. At this act were present Canavesio Giovanni, age 52, ..., and B... Paolo, age 50, hair dresser both residents of this town. The document presented was: the marriage banns posted in this city and in Moncalieri on the 10th and 17th of this November, I read the act of the witnesses and declarant and it was signed by all

## COMORIO - 1896-1905 10-Year Birth Index from City of Torino - Children of Surname Comorio

Due to the large population of the City of Torino where upwards of 3000 children were born and had their births registered per year before a search was completed to find a birth record for Maddalena Comorio genealogist consulted a 10-year birth index from the City of Torino dating from 1896-1905 . The birth index recorded the names of all the children who had their births registered in the City of Torino and it was organized by surname. The surname 'Comorio' was discovered and two birth index entries were noted as being related to our subjects (1) 1899 Birth Index Entry for Maddalena Antonia, No. 1401, Pt. 1 and (2) 1896 Birth Index Entry for Giuseppe, No. 2730, Pt. 2.

of this month [May], at a home on via Carena, number 3,

gave birth to a child of the female sex who was presented before me and given the names

### **Maddalena Antonia**

Two witnesses to this act were Bruno Natale, age 35, carver/engraver, and Marietta Luigi, age 39, marble cutter, both residents of this town.

The declarant was dispensed from having to present the infant for hygienic reasons related to the birth.

The present act was read to all of the witnesses and declarant who all signed below

## Summary of Research Recommendations:

### **(1) Identities of Siblings to Maddalena Antonia Comorio**

Genealogist recommends applying up to two hours of research time completing an on-site digital collections survey of Italian Civil Birth records from the city of Torino at the Familysearch Family History Center in Loudonville, New York, to establish and prove the identities of all siblings to Maddalena Antonia Comorio.

*An On-Site Digital Collections Survey at the Familysearch Family History Center in Loudonville, New York is a term we use to describe a research survey that must be performed at a Familysearch Family History Centers. Familysearch offers remote access to the public of some digitized record collections, but many of digitized record collections are locked from the public and only accessible to the public on-site at Familysearch Family History Centers using a special portal.*

### **(2) Identity & Direct Ancestors of Gioachino Giacinto Comorio**

Genealogist recommends applying up to one hour and thirty minutes of research time completing an on-site digital collections survey of Italian Civil vital records from Pino Torinese at the Familysearch Family History Center in Loudonville, New York, on the identity and direct ancestors of Gioachino Giacinto Comorio.

### **(3) Identity & Direct Ancestors of Chiara Stapinato**

Genealogist recommends applying up to one hour and thirty minutes of research time completing an on-site digital collections survey of Italian Civil vital records from Carignano at the Familysearch Family History Center in Loudonville, New York, on the identity and direct ancestors of Chiara Stapinato.

### **(4) Processetti or 'Marriage Documents' Presented by Gioachino Giacinto Comorio and Chiara Stapinato**

Due to the large population of Torino the processetti or folio of marriage documents presented by the bride and groom were unable to be found efficiently because there were up to 3000 marriages performed a year and the orders were grouped by year but not in chronological order. Genealogist has the order number of the marriage record for the couple and will be able to continue to search for it if client so desires. Genealogist recommends applying up to one hour of research time completing an on-site digital collections survey of Italian Civil vital records from Torino at the Familysearch Family History Center in Loudonville, New York, to find the processetti or folio of marriage documents presented by the bride and groom shortly before their marriage in 1895.
