The purpose of this report is to summarize the data and goals for your project. Please review the information in this report carefully and report if any additional information is known at project start or if any of the information should be changed or corrected.

Summary of Research Recommendations:

Client expressed an interest in learning more about the identity, siblings and direct ancestors of Anthony Pasquale Murray [DiPasquale] with an emphasis to determine his specific place of origin as well as the identities of the siblings to Giuseppe 'Joseph' Glorioso born in Geraci, Siculo, Palermo, Sicilia, Italy. The goals of the survey will be to verify and prove what is known at project start and to establish and prove the identities of previously unknown direct ancestors.

Client provided genealogist with access to her sources at project start which included a family tree and original documents before any research time has been applied. Genealogist also reviewed the research results completed by Capital Genealogy dated 9-28-2018 because those findings included sources on the Murray [DiPasquale] and Glorioso lineages. It is important to note that because the specific place of origin has been confirmed for the Glorioso and Scancarello lineages research recommendations can be proposed to learn more about the identities of the direct ancestors to Giuseppe 'Joseph' Glorioso and Giuseppe 'Josephine' Scancarello.

Genealogist analyzed sources and created an inventory of the most genealogically relevant documents below. The information from the documents was interpreted and used to create the pedigree chart at the end of this report.

Genealogist recommends applying up to two hours of research time completing a digital collections survey on the identity, siblings and direct ancestors of Anthony Pasquale Murray [DiPasquale] with an emphasis to determine his specific place of origin.

(2) Identities of Siblings to Giuseppe 'Joseph' Glorioso & Direct Ancestors of Marie A. Glorioso

Genealogist recommends applying up to two hours of research time completing a digital collections survey of Italian civil records from Geraci Siculo, Palermo, Sicilia, Italy to search to obtain copies of birth records for all children born in Italy to Antonio 'Antonino' Glorioso and Maria Antonia Failla as well as copies of original birth and marriage records for the identities of direct ancestors to Marie A. Glorioso going as far back as possible in time.

Digital Collections Survey is a term we use to describe a research survey that exhausts all available collections of documents that are published online including but not limited to Ancestry.com and other premium information service databases. Copies of original documentation may include census, vital, military, probate, land and church records; secondary documentation may include copies of record transcriptions, record index entries and published genealogies.

1. Digital Collections Survey, Up to 2 hours research time

 Research survey on the identity, siblings and direct ancestors of Anthony Pasquale Murray [DiPasquale] that will search all available collections of documents that are published online including but not limited to Ancestry.com premium databases. Copies of original documentation may include census, vital, military, probate, land and church records; secondary documentation may include copies of record transcriptions, record index entries and published genealogies.

 Research survey of Italian civil birth records from Geraci Siculo, Palermo, Sicilia, Italy to search for and obtain copies of birth records for all children born in Italy to Antonio 'Antonino' Glorioso and Maria Antonia Failla as well as to search for and obtain copies of birth records for all children born in Italy to Antonio 'Antonino' Glorioso and Maria Antonia Failla and copies of original birth and marriage records for the identities of direct ancestors to Marie A. Glorioso.
