Summary of Research Results:

One hour of research time was applied completing a digital collections survey to learn more about the identity of Luigi De Lucca with an emphasis to continue searching to find a copy of an original U.S. record on our subject that may report his specific place of origin like his migration record from circa 1890 as well as determining the Roman Catholic parish he was married at during 1903.

The research survey yielded nine positive results; specifically, a combination of U.S. census and vital records and a naturalization index entry related to the identity of Luigi De Lucca. It was proven during this phase that our subject was first married to a woman named Teresa Palledino[?] born circa 1870 in Italy and that they were married before the birth of their sons Frank and Cataldo[Charles] DeLucca in 1887 and 1898 respectively. It seems that more children were born to Luigi and his first wife between 1888 and 1897, but it was not possible to establish the identities of children born to the couple within the research time allotted. It was not possible to find a migration record for our subject nor was it possible to narrow down the name of the Roman Catholic parish he may have been married in 1903.

The genealogist applied time to learning more about the first wife of Luigi De Lucca with the idea of it being possible that they may have shared a common place of origin, but no evidence was found yet on either individual to establish and prove a specific place of Italian origin. It was discovered that within a two year span the three youngest children born to the couple as well as Teresa died from various causes in Worcester. One child named Raffaele possibly a girl or boy died of scarlet fever and pneumonia in 1900, another an unnamed male was born premature but lived for four days after birth during the summer of 1902, Teresa died from consumption[tuberculosis] during the fall of 1902 and less than two months after the death of Teresa a child named Carmela[Carmino?] possibly a girl or boy died from tubercular meningitis.

An important clue was discovered towards the end of the survey and it was a naturalization index entry from Onondaga County, New York that may be related to our subject. Genealogist found an entry that reported a man named Luigi Delucca applied to become a citizen of the U.S. at one point in time and a specific petition number was provided. It will be important to obtain this record for analysis to determine if it is related to our subject and if so it may mention more details about his specific date and place of birth as well as as date, place and method of entry into the U.S.

Summary of Research Recommendations:

Genealogist recommends applying up to one hour and thirty minutes of research time completing a digital collections survey on the identity of Luigi Delucca and his first wife Teresa Palladino[?] to search for data that may report their specific place of origin.

Digital Collections Survey is a term we use to describe a research survey that exhausts all available collections of documents that are published online including but not limited to Ancestry.com and other premium information service databases. Copies of original documentation may include census, vital, military, probate, land and church records; secondary documentation may include copies of record transcriptions, record index entries and published genealogies.

Genealogist recommends applying up to thirty minutes of correspondence time requesting a copy of an original naturalization record for Luigi 'Deluca' from the Onondaga County Clerk. The record search and copy fee may cost up to \$22.

Correspondence Time is a term we use to describe research tasks that involve direct contacts with government agencies, historical societies, or other entities to submit requests for documents; often including the completion of formal request forms, emails, or mail correspondence. Correspondence tasks are billed at half our normal research rate.



Itemized List of Research Recommendations:

1. **Digital Collections Survey**, Up to 1.5 hours research time

- Research survey on the identity of Luigi Delucca and his first wife Teresa Palladino[?] to search for data that may report their specific place of origin that will search all available collections of documents that are published online including but not limited to Ancestry.com premium databases. Copies of original documentation may include census, vital, military, probate, land and church records; secondary documentation may include copies of record transcriptions, record index entries and published genealogies.

2. **Correspondence**, Up to .5-hours correspondence time + up to \$22 record copy fees

- To submit a request to the Onondaga County Clerk to search and obtain the naturalization record for Luigi Delucca [Bk. 60, No. 16458]
