

Research Results Report Tara A. Fantauzzi, Professional Genealogist

Summary of Research Results:

Two hours of research time was applied completing a digital collections survey to learn more about the identity of Luigi 'Louis' DeLuca as well as any extended family with an emphasis to establish and prove a specific place of origin in Italy.

The research survey and correspondence work yielded twelve positive results; specifically, a combination of Italian vital records as well as U.S. census, vital, and military records and record index entries related to the identity of Luigi 'Louis' DeLuca and a DeLuca family who settled in Worcester that led the genealogist to discover the families shared a common place of origin in Brienza, Potenza, Basilicata, Italy.

It is important to note that one of the most important records found during this survey was a copy of an original 1888 Italian civil marriage registration for Luigi DeLuca and Maria Teresa Coppola from Brienza. This record reported the parents of the groom were Catalado DeLuca and Raffaela DiStefano, which cross matches against the parents Luigi DeLuca listed on a U.S. marriage record to his second wife Maria Razzano that occurred during 1903.

The 1888 Italian civil marriage registration reported the groom was born circa 1865 in Brienza and the genealogist searched to find a copy of his original Italian civil birth registration, but that year was missing from the digitized record. The genealogist reviewed births that were registered in 1864, 1866-1868, but no record matches were found. It may be possible a copy of his original Italian civil birth record may be available at the municipal level.

Research Results - Documents:

DELUCA - 1881 Italian Civil Birth Registration for Carolina Deluca

This is an 1881 Italian civil birth registration for 'Carolina' DeLuca who later went by the name Camilla in the U.S. She was found on a 1900 Federal population census as a resident of Worcester living as a married woman (to Carlo Santo or DeSanto) with her parents Giuseppe and Maria Rosaria Scelza. After this record was found the genealogist searched for documentation on our subject Luigi 'Louis' DeLuca and was unable to find an 1865 birth registration for him, but found his 1888 Italian civil marriage registration to his first wife Maria Teresa Coppola.

DELUCA - 1888 Italian Civil Marriage Registration for Luigi DiLuca & Maria Teresa Coppola

This marriage record reported that Luigi DeLuca married Maria Teresa Coppola on the 15th of November 1888 in Brienza. It further stated that Luigi DeLuca was born circa 1865 in Brienza to the living Caltaldo DeLuca and the deceased Raffaela DiStefano. His wife Maria Teresa Coppola was reported to have been born circa 1870 in Brienza to a mother named Carmela Coppola and a father whose identity was unknown.

DELUCA - 1903 Roman Catholic marriage registration for Ludovicum Di Lucca & Mariam Razzano

After the genealogist contacted many different Roman Catholic parishes in Worcester a marriage record was found at the parish of St. Stephen to for Luigi Di Lucca & Mary Razzano. The record reported they celebrated their marriage on the 9th of June 1903 and were married by M.P. Kavanagh. The record did not report the specific places of origin for the bride and groom, but it did indicate the witnesses to the marriage were Cataldus Di Lucca & Maria Di Lucca. The genealogist investigated the identities of both witnesses which lead to the discovery of a DeLuca family who settled in Worcester that shared a common place of origin known as Brienza, Potenza, Basilicata, Italy.

SANTO - 1898 Marriage Registration for Cataldo Santo & Maria C. De Luca

This record was pulled as proof of marriage for Maria C. De Luca daughter of Giuseppe and Maria R. Scelza who is also known as Camilla on a 1900 Federal population census found by the genealogist on the DeLuca family in Worcester. A copy of her original 1881 Italian civil birth registration was found to prove she was born in Brienza to Giuseppe DeLuca and Maria Rosa Scelza. Her husband Cataldo Santo was also born in Brienza as proven by a copy of his 1942 WWII draft registration found by the genealogist.

- Was not advised to contact Our Lady of Mount Camel & Our Lady of Loreto parish b/c it did not open until 1906
 - OUR LADY'S HISTORY The early Italian immigrants in Worcester attended Mass and Devotions at St. Stephen's Church (Irish Parish) located on Grafton Hill. As the number of Italians increased, it became evident that a parish would have to be established for them in order that they may work in their native tongue. In 1894 Father Miglione launched a drive to organize a parish for the Italian speaking people. He worked hard on this project for five years without success. At the turn of the century, Italians in Worcester numbered about 4,000. In 1904 Monsignor Gioacchino Maffei arrived in Worcester to become spiritual leader of this large group. He at once renewed the project abandoned by Father Miglione. With the help of his people, Monsignor Maffei purchased a building at the corner of Eastern Avenue and Mulberry Street from the Swedish Baptist community. In November 1906 Bishop Beaven came to Worcester, officially established the new parish of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, and blessed the building which was to be the church of the new parish.
