



Initial Consultation Report from Tara A. Fantauzzi Patregnani Professional Genealogist

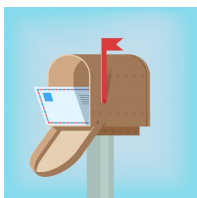


Summary of Research Recommendations:

The purpose of this report is to summarize the data and goals for your project. Please review the information in this report carefully and report if any additional information is known at project start or if any of the information should be changed or corrected.

Like we discussed, I received a proposal from the company Historikerkanzlei from genealogist Marion Mauracher to obtain a certified copy of an original 1923 Tunisian birth record for Mathilde Farrugia. Ms. Mauracher proposed that her company can obtain a certified copy of her original birth record for the purposes of an Italian dual citizenship application for 250 Euro plus shipping fees. Ms. Mauracher explained that there is no contract necessary, and that an email stating that we want to move forward is sufficient enough along with payment for her company to move forward. I cannot guarantee the outcome of this case. I have not yet confirmed the total for shipping fees.

I recommend applying up to thirty minutes of correspondence time submitting a formal request and payment to Historikerkanzlei to search and if found obtain a certified copy of an original 1923 Tunisian birth record for Mathilde Farrugia. As part of the formal request I will write up what we know regarding our subject as well as submit an image of her baptismal record for the company to reference before they begin the search.
