- (7) Identity of John Thomas Fifteen minutes of correspondence time submitting a request to the New Jersey State Archives to search and obtain a copy of an original death registration for John Thomas who died on the 4th of February 1878 in Hoboken.
- (8) Identity of Mary McGuinness One hour of research time completing a digital collections survey on the identity of Mary McGuiness with an emphasis to establish and prove her specific place of Irish origin as well as the identities of her parents.



The research survey and correspondence work yielded twenty-eight positive results; specifically, a combination of Irish & English vital records as well as U.S. census, vital and probate records, as well as record index entries.

## WILLIAMS - Research Note for Discussion - Possible Connection to Roger Williams - Mayflower Society

At the beginning of the survey I noted the 1850 Federal population census for Thomas P. Williams reported he lived nearby two other Williams households specifically a W.S. Williams, age 38, and Samuel Williams, age 27. I applied research time to investigate the identities of W.S. Williams and Samuel Williams with a goal to determine if I could find proof to determine if there was a familial relationship, and if so what type, that was shared amongst those Williams' men. In conclusion it seems highly likely that both William Stanton (W.S.) Williams and Samuel Williams were brothers to the direct ancestor of client Thomas P. Williams.

An unsourced note on a U.S. burial index entry for W.S. Williams reported he is a direct descendant of the Mayflower Roger Williams. It seems highly likely Thomas P. Williams, W.S. Williams and Samuel Williams were children of Jeremiah Williams and Charity Stanton. It was discovered that Jeremiah Williams died without a will, which means no probate record was found that named all the children of the deceased Jeremiah Williams.
