



Initial Consultation Report from Tara Patregnani Professional Genealogist



Summary of Research Recommendations:

(1) Identity of Edward McLaughlin

Client submitted a copy of an original Irish birth registration for a child named Edward McLaughlin born on the 4th of October 1872 in Kilmacrennan, County Donegal, Ireland to parents Edward McLaughlin and Catherine McGettigin. The date of birth on the birth registration submitted is the same date of birth listed for Edward McLaughlin on a copy of his original 1938 death certificate, which helps to prove the birth record from Ireland may be for the right person.

I recommend applying up to one hour of research time completing a digital collections survey on the identity, siblings and direct ancestors of Edward McLaughlin with a goal to find more proof to help cross check the identity of the child named Edward McLaughlin on the 1872 Irish birth record against our subject. If it is possible to efficiently prove they are the same person then research time will be applied to learn more about the identities of his direct ancestors beginning with his parents.

(2) Identity & Direct Ancestors of Elizabeth M. McNulty

I recommend applying up to thirty minutes of research time completing a digital collections survey on the identity and direct ancestors of Elizabeth M. McNulty with a goal to at least find more proof to help cross check the identity of the child named Elizabeth McNulty on the 1875 Irish birth record against our subject. If it is possible to efficiently prove they are the same person then research time will be applied to learn more about the identities of her direct ancestors beginning with her parents.

(3) Identity & Direct Ancestors of Catherine Joyce

I recommend applying up to thirty minutes of research time completing a digital collections survey on the identity and direct ancestors of Catherine Joyce with a goal to at least find more proof to help cross check the identity of the child named Catherine Joy on the 1875 Irish birth record against our subject. If it is possible to efficiently prove they are the same person then research time will be applied to learn more about the identities of her direct ancestors beginning with her parents.



(4) Identity & Direct Ancestors of James Patrick White

I recommend applying up to one hour of research time completing a digital collections survey on the identity and direct ancestors of James Patrick White with a goal to at least find more proof to help cross check the identity of the child named James Patrick White in the 1866 Irish birth record against our subject. If it is possible to efficiently prove they are the same person then research time will be applied to learn more about the identities of his direct ancestors beginning with his parents.

(5) Direct Ancestors of Thomas P. Williams

I recommend applying up to three hours of research time completing a digital collections survey on the direct ancestors of Thomas P. Williams with a priority to learn as much as possible regarding the direct William's lineage to determine if that line is descendant of Roger Williams or a direct ancestor who served during the Revolutionary War.

(6) Identity, Siblings & Direct Ancestors of George E. Robinson

I recommend applying up to two hours of research time to continue completing a digital collections survey on the identity, siblings and direct ancestors of George E. Robinson.

(7) Direct Ancestors of Nettie Mae Tillotson

I recommend applying up to two hours of research time completing a digital collections survey on the direct ancestors of Nettie Mae Tillotson.

(8) Direct Ancestors of Henry Barker

I recommend applying up to two hours of research time to continue completing a digital collections survey on direct ancestors of Henry Barker.

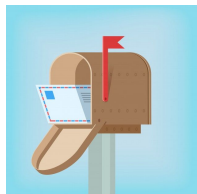
(9) Identity of Mary McGuinness

I recommend applying up to thirty minutes of research time completing a digital collections survey on the identity of Mary McGuinness to establish and prove the identities of her parents or at least to establish and prove her date and place of birth.

After the research survey is completed I recommend applying up to fifteen minutes of correspondence time requesting a copy of an original Irish birth registration for our subject Mary McGuinness from the Irish General Registration Office.



Digital Collections Survey is a term we use to describe a research survey that exhausts all available collections of documents that are published online including but not limited to Ancestry.com and other premium information service databases. Copies of original documentation may include census, vital, military, probate, land and church records; secondary documentation may include copies of record transcriptions, record index entries and published genealogies.



Correspondence Time is a term we use to describe research tasks that involve direct contacts with government agencies, historical societies, or other entities to submit requests for documents; often including the completion of formal request forms, emails, or mail correspondence. Correspondence tasks are billed at half our normal research rate.

4. Digital Collections Survey, Up to 1 hour research time

- Research survey on the identity and direct ancestors of James Patrick White that will search all available collections of documents that are published online including but not limited to Ancestry.com premium databases. Copies of original documentation may include census, vital, military, probate, land and church records; secondary documentation may include copies of record transcriptions, record index entries and published genealogies.

5. Digital Collections Survey, Up to 3 hours research time

- Research survey on the direct ancestors of Thomas P. Williams with an emphasis to learn more about the Williams lineage that will search all available collections of documents that are published online including but not limited to Ancestry.com premium databases. Copies of original documentation may include census, vital, military, probate, land and church records; secondary documentation may include copies of record transcriptions, record index entries and published genealogies.

**6. Digital Collections Survey, Up to 2 hours research time**

- Research survey on the identity, siblings and direct ancestors of William Robinson that will search all available collections of documents that are published online including but not limited to Ancestry.com premium databases. Copies of original documentation may include census, vital, military, probate, land and church records; secondary documentation may include copies of record transcriptions, record index entries and published genealogies.

7. Digital Collections Survey, Up to 2 hours research time

- Research survey on the direct ancestors of Nettie Mae Tillotson that will search all available collections of documents that are published online including but not limited to Ancestry.com premium databases. Copies of original documentation may include census, vital, military, probate, land and church records; secondary documentation may include copies of record transcriptions, record index entries and published genealogies.
