

Research Results Report from Tara A. Fantauzzi Patregnani Professional Genealogist



Summary of Research Results:

I reviewed the email submitted prior to project start and noted that our subjects are Patrick Toole and Margaret Doyle. I also noted on the Ancestry member account a typed, published sheet on the O'Tool/Doyle family reported the family had the following children: Mary in 1832, Thomas in 1836, Peter in 1842, James circa 1845 and Patrick in 1845.

Two hours of research time was applied completing a digital collections survey of at least the Roman Catholic parish records from 'Killaveny' to find (1) proof of marriage for Margaret Doyle to Peter O'Toole, (2) proof of baptism for at least a son referred to as Peter O'Toole born circa 1842 and (3) proof of baptism for men who may be brothers to Margaret Doyle mentioned in the Initial Consultation Report dated 5-24-2019, "John Doyle, James Doyle, Patrick Doyle, John Bernard Doyle and Hugh Doyle who settled in Tecumseth township."

The research survey yielded two positive results; specifically, two Roman Catholic baptism records from the parish of Killaveny, Diocese of Ferns, variant forms of this parish were said to be 'Annacurra', 'Annacorra' and 'Anacorra' for children baptized there who were the children of Patrick Toole and Margaret Doyle. I started the survey by searching to find a marriage registration for the couple at this parish beginning in 1829, but was unable to find a record match after looking until as late as 1834. Next, I surveyed baptisms beginning in 1831 around the time the couple was said to have had their first born child, and ended up finding a baptism record for Thomas Toole in 1832 followed by a baptism record for Michael Toole in 1836. Before I develop specific research recommendations I want to discuss the outcome of this survey and future research goals.

TOOLE - 1832 Baptismal Record for Thomas Toole - son of Pat. Toole & Margt. Doyle - Ballyshonaugh

This record reported that Thomas Toole born to Patrick Toole and Margaret Doyle was baptized on the 13th of June 1832. Below are two views of the record I found using a digitized collection of Catholic Parish Registration at the National Library of Ireland. The record was the parish of Killaveny, Diocese of Ferns, variant forms of this parish were said to be 'Annacurra', 'Annacorra' and 'Anacorra'. On your Ancestry member account a typed, published sheet on the O'Tool/Doyle family reported the family had the following children: Mary in 1832, Thomas in 1836, Peter in 1842, James circa 1845 and Patrick in 1845. This record helps to prove that the child named Thomas was baptized in June 1832, which means he was likely born shortly before as it was common for baptisms in Ireland to be performed shortly after birth.

This record helps to prove that the child named Michael was baptized in July 1836, which means he was likely born shortly before as it was common for baptisms in Ireland to be performed shortly after birth.
