

Research Results Report from Tara A. Fantauzzi Patregnani Professional Genealogist



Summary of Research Results:

(1) Identity of Maria Teresa Coppola a.k.a Teresa Palladino

At the beginning of the survey I looked back at all the previous evidence obtained and discovered we already have a copy of an original death certificate from 1902 for Teresa Palladino DeLuca who died in Worcester, Massachusetts that year. An obstacle to overcome is that the maiden name of Teresa according to her Italian marriage record was Coppola, and on the 1902 death record it was recorded as being Palladino. It is important to note that the 1902 death record that was found for Teresa Palladino reported her mother was Carmela Coppola and that cross checks against the identity of the mother Teresa listed on her marriage record from Brienza that dates from 1888. The identity of the father to Teresa was not listed on the 1888 marriage record most likely because his identity was unknown.

The surname for Teresa in the U.S. was reported on more than one document as Palladino, including birth records for her children born in the U.S. as well as her death record. To make sense of the two maiden names I applied research time to survey birth records from Brienza dating from 1866 to 1875, but was unable to find a birth record for Maria Teresa Coppola or just Maria Coppola or just Teresa Coppola in Brienza. I went back and surveyed birth records from Brienza dating from 1886 to 1875 to find a birth record for Teresa under the surname Palladino, which I noted to be popular amongst residents in Brieza during the time she was born there.

Lastly, since it was common for Italian women to travel under their maiden name, I searched to find a migration record for Maria Teresa Coppola or Palladino arriving at the Port of New York, Boston or another port found by doing index searches. I was unable to find a record match that could be related back to our subject and that is likely a symptom of migration records from the late 1890s because those records typically did not contain a lot of identifying information like place of origin, members of family left behind and who they planned to join. I am hesitant to recommend applying more research time until we have a discussion of the research results and strategies moving forward.



(2) Identity of James 'Vincenzo' De Luca & Mary 'Minnie' Amarando

Two hours of research time was applied completing a digital collections survey to learn more about the identities of James 'Vincenzo' De Luca and Mary 'Minnie' Amarando to find proof to answer lingering questions regarding their lives over time which will lead to finding vital records that have not been found yet for your Italian dual citizenship application.

I was able to fulfill all of our research goals for this topic including: (1) to determine a specific date and place of marriage for the couple, which was the 26th of August 1922 in Syracuse (2) the specific date and place of death for James 'Vincenzo' De Luca was narrowed down to February 1988 most likely in Syracuse and (3) the specific date and place of birth for Mary 'Minnie' Amarando. She was born in Sarno where her parents were born and married. I was unable to find a digitized copy of her birth record because births from 1903 were not part of the digitized record.

(3) Vital Records for Italian Dual Citizenship

I applied one hour of correspondence time to put together a specific plan to obtain the remaining vital records related to your paternal ancestors for the purposes of your Italian dual citizenship. The outcome is a table on your Customer Dashboard with links to specific vital records agencies to complete requests to obtain certified vital records for herself back through her paternal line to Italian migrant ancestors Luigi De Luca and Mariagrazia Razzano.

I noted that a specific date and place of death was not recorded in my database for Luigi De Luca and Mariagrazia Razzano but it is believed they died after 1930. If you know the dates and places of their death please let me know and I will add instructions to the table to obtain copies of their death records. If we are not sure what their dates and places of death are I can make a recommendation to apply research time for proof of their deaths.

The research survey and correspondence work yielded fourteen positive results; specifically, a combination of Italian and U.S. census, military, vital, migration records, record transcriptions, and record index entries.
