Subjects of Focus: Direct Ancestors of Client Scott Salvator

The purpose of this report is to summarize the data and goals for your project. Please review the information in this report carefully and report if any additional information is known at project start or if any of the information should be changed or corrected.

Client has a desire to verify and prove the identities of his known direct ancestors beginning with parents with a goal to establish and prove the identities of his previously unknown direct ancestors going as far back in time as possible. Another goal of this survey will be to establish and prove specific places of origin for all direct ancestors proven to have been born outside the United States. It seems likely that three of the lineages related client had origins from Italy and one line likely originated from Ireland.

For genealogist to identify European records for survey the specific places of origin must be proven for any ancestors born overseas. Another important fact to verify during this first phase will be the identities of the parents to those who migrated from Europe to the U.S. Verifying both proof of specific place of origin as well as the identities of the parents to each subject ensures genealogist can complete an accurate survey of records from Europe. Without those facts it can be easy to associate an individual with the wrong immediate family.

Client submitted a substantial amount of anecdotal information on our subjects of focus which genealogist took note of and will use as a reference as the research time is applied because those notes will help to confirm evidence found during the research survey are for the correct individuals. Genealogist updated the pedigree chart at the end of this report to reflect edits made to the facts related to the direct ancestors of client.

The father of client George Anthony Salvadore was said to have been born on the 11th of February 1931 in Ogdensburg, St. Lawrence County, New York and died on the 15th of March 1998 in Lawrenceville, Mercer County, New Jersey. A copy of his original obituary was submitted by client. The parents of George A. Salvadore were described to have been Anthony Salvadore and Leola A. Kelly. Little specific information is known about Anthony Salvadore, but he likely died in Florida during 1979 and the obituary submitted for his wife Leola A. Kelly helps to prove he predeceased her. No copies of original documentation have been obtained yet on the identity of Anthony Salvadore and the identities of his parents have not been established yet, although it is known they likely had family with origins from Italy. At one point in time most likely before 1931 Anthony Salvadore married Leola A. Kelly. A transcription of her original obituary was submitted, and it reported she was born on the 25th of June 1910 in Berlin, Coos County,

New Hampshire to Dennis Kelly and Matilda Schumaker. Her obituary reported she died on the 14th of April 2005 in New Milford, Burlington County, New Jersey. It is believed that her family had origins from a place in Ireland that is not yet known. A copy of an original obituary was also submitted for Anthony Salvadore Jr., brother of George A. Salvadore.

Eleanor Pinto, mother of client was born on the 1st of December 1936 and graduated high school in Trenton, New Jersey in 1954. The parents of Eleanor Pinto were said to have been Anthony Rudolph Pinto and Elsie Rose Carolonza. It is not clear where Anthony Rudolph Pinto was born, but he was described to have been born on the 23rd of April 1907. The identities of his parents are not yet known, and the specific date of marriage for Anthony Rudolph Pinto to Elsie Rose Carolonza has not been established yet, though it likely may have occurred before 1936. Anthony R. Pinto was said to have been born in Scranton, Lackawanna County, Pennsylvania, and died on the 15th of March 1988 in Lawrenceville, Mercer County, New Jersey, and the identities of his parents has not yet been established. It is possible his family had origins from a location in Italy. Elsie Rose Carolonza was noted to have been born on the 24th of January 1913 in Orange, New Jersey and died on the 27th of March 2001 in Lawrenceville, Mercer County, New Jersey. The identities of the parents to Elsie Rose Carolonza have not been established yet but may have had origins from Italy. An obituary was submitted for Lois Summers, sister of Eleanor Pinto.
