Subjects of Focus: Direct Ancestors of Diane Krasnica Lippert

The purpose of this report is to summarize the data and goals for your project. Please review the information in this report carefully and report if any additional information is known at project start or if any of the information should be changed or corrected.

Client has a desire to verify and prove the identities of her known paternal and maternal direct ancestors beginning with her parents, with an emphasis to establish and prove the identities of her paternal and maternal direct ancestors whose identities are not yet known. Other goals of this research survey will be to establish and prove specific places of European origin for direct ancestors who were migrants to the United States. Client submitted a pedigree chart to visualize what is known at project start along with extensive secondary notes related to her direct ancestors and their descendants.

The secondary notes reference copies of original documentation like WWII draft cards and census records, but no copies of those documents are available today to pass onto genealogist. If client knows a family member who maintains an active Ancestry member tree with the data referenced from the secondary notes it will be important to share access to that tree with genealogist to prevent duplicating research that was previously completed.

Joseph Charles Kransica, father of client, was born on the 22nd of June 1921 in Wharton, Morris County, New Jersey to Joseph 'Kvasnica' and Anna Dulla. He was one of at least four children born to the couple and his siblings were Mary (half-sibling), Steven and Vincent. He later married Wanda Loretta Boturla at St. Anne's Church in Jersey City, New Jersey on the 12th of February (the year was not reported). Joseph C. Kransica died on the 28th of August 2002 in Edison, New Jersey. Little is known about the identity of Joseph 'Kvasnica' except that he may have been born in Slovaki, married at a borough of New York City and later died in Jersey City, New Jersey during 1928. Anna Dulla was reported to have been born on the 19th of August 1888 in 'Benadova', Slovakia, but the identities of her parents at not yet known. It was said that Anna Dulla later died during December 1974 at the Monmouth Medical Center. It was noted that Anna likely came to the U.S. with a sister named Paulina. It was also noted that Anna Dulla was a member of Our Lady of Czestichowa in Jersey City, New Jersey.

Wanda Loretta Boturla, mother of client, was said to have been born on the 19th of October 1924 in Jersey City, New Jersey to Peter Boturla (Fischer) and Mariana Jonak. It was said that Wanda was one of seven children born to the couple and her siblings were Julia (Mae), Peter, William, Joseph, Helen, and John. Wanda was later said to have died

on the 29th of April 2017 at her home in Fords, New Jersey. Peter Boturla (Fischer) was reported to have been born on the 6th of September 1889 in 'White', Russia, or Poland, but the identities of his parents are not yet known. He may have been married on the 26th of November, but his specific date of marriage to Mariana Jonak has not been established yet. Peter was described to have later died during 1939 in Jersey City, New Jersey and during his lifetime was a tavern owner. Mariana Jonak was said to have been born on the 15th of December at an unknown location in Poland, but her year of birth is not yet known. She later was said to have died on the 12th of October during an unknown year in Jersey City, New Jersey. It was said that Mariana Jonak came to the U.S. during 1906 with a brother named Stanley who removed to Cleveland, Ohio and later had a daughter.
